

## **NORTH CAROLINA CARDINAL CLASSIC BREEDERS FUTURITY AND STALLION AUCTION RULES**

1. Stallion service must sell for foals to be eligible for the Breeders Futurity.
2. Bidding will begin at 50% of the advertised stud fee with a minimum bid of \$250.00 by mail-in bid form. No less than 20% Plus a \$25.00 office fee to be paid at the time of purchase. Mail-in bid, absentee bids will be accepted if postmarked no later than the date listed February 1st (every year). If absentee bid is the final bid, purchaser will be notified within 24 hours. A payment of at least 20% plus office fee will be due within 10 business days to avoid forfeiture of stallion service purchase. After said date unsold stallions will be available for purchase at 60% of the advertised stud fee plus a \$25.00 office fee.
3. Stallion Nomination Applications must be completed and signed by owner of stallion than submitted to the Futurity Chairperson.
4. Stallion services may be purchased after July 31st at 75% of fee until December 31st. After December 31st stallion services can be purchased at full stud fee plus 25% of fee as long as received postmarked by September 15th of Futurity year.
5. Make checks payable to the North Carolina Cardinal Classic Breeders Futurity.(NCCCBF)
6. Any services not paid in full within 30 days of purchase will be resold. Deposit will be forfeited.
7. Stallions standing at private treaty or not standing to the public will have a minimum fee of \$400.00 plus office fee.
8. NC breeder's futurity reserves the right to refuse bids from anyone not in good standing with the NC breeder's futurity or the APHA.
9. NC breeder's futurity will not be responsible for any misrepresentation on the mare or stallion owners
10. Mare owners must comply with the stallion owners breeding contract.
11. Stallion owner will be expected to guarantee a live foal (stand and nurse) If a live foal is not produced the mare owner may return the next year for rebreeding. If after two breeding seasons a live foal has not been produced the stallion owner will no longer be considered responsible for any subsequent rebreeding.
12. In the event of the following should occur:
  - A. Stallion sold or moved to another location
  - B. Stallion dies before mare is bred
  - C. Mare dies before being bred
  - D. Mare is found unfit for breedingThe purchaser of the stallion service will be given credit for the purchase of the service and will be allowed to use that credit towards the purchase of another stallion; or substitute another mare; or re-sell the service. No refunds will be allowed.
13. Futurity Chairperson must be notified before any of the above is taken. Stallion owner, service purchaser and Futurity Chairperson must mutually

agree upon all actions. Disputes will be brought before the committee and its ruling will be final.

14. Mare owner is responsible for all breeding expenses.
15. FOALS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH APHA ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL FUTURITY ENTRIES.
16. Breeding Stock Horses are eligible to show in all futurity classes.
17. Futurity will be held in conjunction with the CPHC Cardinal Classic and open futurity held on October \_\_\_\_\_,\_\_\_\_\_.
18. If any class results in a tie, placings will be combined and prize money divided equally. Example: If first place results in a tie, first and second place monies will be added together and divided equally between the tied entries.
19. One place, up to 6 places

1 place	100%
2 places	55%-45%
3 places	45%-35%-20%
4 places	40%-30%-20%-10%
5 places	37%-27%-17%-10%-9%
6 places	33%-23%-15%-13%-9%-7%
20. Exhibitor and owner must be in good standing with both North Carolina Breeder's Futurity and APHA
21. Any futurity entry testing positive for illegal substances and/or tail fixing and ANY Disqualification (DQ) will forfeit any and all futurity monies and awards will be distributed accordingly.
22. The proceeds of the stallion service auction will be distributed as follows:
  - 10%** of class entry fees to the club, balance less expenses paid over a three year period.
  - 50%** weanlings
  - 20%** yearling classes, (5%) lunge line, (5%) mares, (5%) gelding, (5%) stallions
  - 15%** two year old snaffle bit
  - 15%** two year old hunter under saddle
23. Breeders Futurity fee schedule will be as follows:
  - \$150.00 postmarked by September 1st or
  - \$250.00 postmarked after September 1st or received at show.
  - Entries must be paid by 7:00am the day of the show.
24. Futurity winnings will be mailed within 30 days of show unless drug testing is conducted, in which case payout results will be pending till results.
25. The North Carolina Cardinal Classic Breeders Futurity will consist of TEN classes: Jr and Sr Weanling Mares, Jr and Sr Weanling Stallions, Yearling Lunge Line, Yearling Mares, Yearling Geldings, Yearling Stallions, Two Year Old Western Pleasure, Two Year Old Hunter Under Saddle.
26. North Carolina Cardinal Classic Breeders Futurity Committee reserves the right to change its rules at any time. Any provisions involving extenuating circumstances not covered will be resolved by the Futurity Committee.
